


Part A:

The International Business Machines Corporation, better known as IBM, is one of the world's top manufacturers of computer software and hardware. In 2012, the company was ranked as the second largest firm in the United States in terms of employees, with approximately 435,000 workers around the world. It also ranked number four in market capitalization, and was the ninth most profitable firm. The birthplace of IBM is a town called Endicott in New York State.

IBM's hometown suffered environmental pollution because of the company for years. In the 20th century, the company used liquids in the assembly of circuit boards that were extremely harmful to the environment, and numerous spills were reported in the area. These chemicals seeped into the town's soil and drinking water. IBM was also identified as a major source of air pollution in the Endicott area in the 1980s, and it was alleged that several cases of cancer in Endicott were linked to the pollution caused by IBM.

From the year 1990 onward, however, IBM made a concerted effort to clean up its act. In 2010, IBM even topped one news publication's list of the world's greenest companies. It was said that from 1990 until 2009, IBM saved about \$370 million due to its energy saving measures. These measures showed the world that IBM was serious about undoing at least some of the damage it had done to the environment, and was good for the company's bottom line as well.
